E-NEWSLETTER OF MAHESHTALA MUNICIPALITY FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST, 2019

Activities during the month of July 2019

1. Activities under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission: WBSULM (West Bengal State Urban Livelihood Mission):

- Seven new Self Help Groups were formed in this month opened their group savings bank account at various nationalized banks. 77 old SHGs received Basic Orientation Training and Books of Accounts training. From each of the groups five members attended the trainings. Main objectives behind organizing such trainings are to aware members about the mission and impart knowledge on how to maintain books of accounts of the SHGs.



- Seven SHGs were graded and sponsored to bank for cash credit loans. Five SHGs who have got cash credit account for more than a year and repaying regularly have received CC loan, amounting Rs. 2.5 lakhs each. During this month three SHGs which were graded previously have received Cash Credit Loans of Rs. 1.5 lakh each.
- In collaboration with Bangiya Gramin Vikash Bank, Jagannathnagar branch a financial literacy camp was organized. The camp was facilitated by senior personnel of the branch. 45 members from 6 SHGs attended the camp. Manner maintenance of CC account and other financial facilities under different government schemes were discussed.



- Shelter for Urban Homeless, constructed under this project, has been handed over to a NGO for operation and maintenance of the shelter home. Four inmates are presently staying at the facility. Regular night survey is being conducted to rescue shelter less pavement dwellers.



- SHGs are also grouped honored as Mahila Arogya Samiti organized rallies to aware people how to remain safe from the menace of dengue fever. This activity is a part of “Cleanliness Fortnight for Control and Management of Dengue”. The MAS members are able to create awareness among the stakeholders. It is expected that this may influence people to adopt good practices to prevent spread of dengue fever.



2. Activities under National Urban Health Mission:

- 29 Special Outreach Health Camps were organized through which 1170 beneficiaries were catered with medical services. Details of the camps and services given below -
