Activities during the month of February 2021

Activities under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Urban Livelihoods Mission: WBSULM (West Bengal State Urban Livelihood Mission):

Empowerment of Women

Two Self Help Groups (SHG), opened their group savings bank accounts. Seven SHGs received first installment of cash credit loan, as they had secured more than 70% marks in grading exercise. Each of the groups received Rs. 1.5 lakh. Four SHGs received second installment of cash credit loan, @ Rs. 2.5 lakh each. 13 SHG received basic orientation training and book keeping training. These training will help to run the group accurately and keep their financial dealings clear. It would help them to get cash credit loans in near future.



State Swayamsiddha (National Urban Livelihood Mission) Mela was organized by The State Urban Development Agency from 14th to 23rd February, 2021. SHGs from all the Municipalities participated in the fair to exhibit and sale their products. Four SHGs of Maheshtala Municipality participated in the Mela. It was a great exposure for them to participate in such a state level programme and display and sell their product.

Employment through Skill Training & Placement

Under this component eligible youth are getting opportunities to acquire vocational knowledge and skills which is beneficial for their livelihood. From 10th February an online course on 'Hospital Front Desk Coordinator' has been initiated. 28 Participants are now receiving this training.

Activities under National Urban Health Mission (NUHM):

Covid Vaccination

1470 Beneficiaries received first dosage of Covid vaccine from Maheshtala area, and from Budge Budge area 320 beneficiaries received first dosage of Covid vaccine. 221 had received second dosage so far.

542 beneficiaries received ophthalmological services through 'Chokher Alo' from different UPHCs of Maheshtala Municipality.
