Activities during the month of May 2018

1. Activities under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission: WBSULM (West Bengal Urban Livelihood Mission):

- ✓ This mission aims at reduction of poverty and vulnerability of the urban poor households by enabling them to earn access to gainful self employment and skilled wage employment opportunities, resulting in an appreciable upgradation in their livelihood on a sustainable basis, through building strong grassroot level institutions for the poor. Maheshtala Municipality in line with the aim of the mission minutely is focusing on the main pillar of the programme, i.e. formation and strengthening of Self Help Groups. 7 numbers new groups of women have been formed and they have opened their savings bank account. 14 SHGs who have completed at least 3 months and maintaining *Pancha Sutra* received one time revolving fund of rupees ten thousand as seed money.
- ✓ 8 numbers of SHGs got cash credit loan from their respective banks after scrutinizing books of accounts by the competent authority. Each of the groups has received Rupees 1.5 lakh. Three SHGs received Cash Credit loans for the second time for timely repayment and proper maintenance of the books of accounts. Total Rs. 4.71 lacs have been received by these three groups.
- ✓ At present 4 batches of vocational trainings under NULM are going on. 140 Students are attending training on regular basis. Training of basic sewing and tailoring course completed and vocational examination was taken by the institute that provided the training.

Meeting of Mahila Arogya Samiti:

On 25th May a meeting of MAS was organized, where around 125 members were present. This meeting was mainly focused to aware them about the upcoming health camps of the month of June 2018. Through the meeting previous learning on their role was refurbished. In the meeting it was reiterated increase the foot fall in the health outreach camps.



2. Activities under National Urban Health Mission (NUHM)

✓ Special Outreach Health Camps

20 Special outreach health camps were organized in this month to serve the marginalized people with preventive and curative health care. They were also given medicines as per the prescriptions of the attending Physician. Details about the camps are given below.
