Activities during the month of October 2022

Activities under National Urban Health Mission:

Pradhan Mantri Surakshit Matritva Abhiyan (PMSMA) is a special initiative for pregnant women to ensure safe child birth through comprehensive and quality antenatal care. During this month 180 pregnant women received antenatal health checkup and advice was given as per requirement.



27 Special Outreach Health Camps were held this month, total 942 beneficiaries received health care services through these camps.





Activities under National Urban Livelihood Mission: WBSULM (West Bengal State Urban Livelihood Mission):

Shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH)

During Durga Puja special meal for the inmates were arranged by the different Puja committees and individuals as well. Five special meals were arranged during the month.



Monthly health check up camp was organized on 17th October, and as per prescription of doctor, medicines were also provided to the inmates.





Empowerment of Women

Capacity Building training of forty members from eight Area Level Federations (ALF) were conducted this month. During training they were taught about different soft skills communication, leadership etc.

Besides they were also taught about roles and responsibilities of ALF and its office bearers.

New group savings bank accounts are opened by two new Self Help Groups (SHG). They have started micro savings activities.

One SHG received first Cash Credit Loans, amounting Rs. 1.5 lakh, Two SHGs received second Cash Credit Loans, amounting Rs. 2.5 lakh and one SHG received third Cash Credit loan amounting Rs 3.5 lakh.

Activities of Mahila Arogya Samiti (MAS):

Active SHGs which are working as Mahila Arogya Samiti putting tremendous effort to apprise people regarding prevention of spread of dengue. Since Durga Puja Dengue has taken monstrous dimension, through regular meeting in collaboration with ASHA and other ground level health workers MAS members are trying to appraise people so that it can be prevented.

A mass rally of MAS members were organized on 20th October, MAS members took a pivotal role in the rally. Beside them CICs, Councillors, ULB Officials were also present in the rally.
