E-NEWSLETTER OF MAHESHTALA MUNICIPALITY FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 2016

Activities during the month of September, 2016.

1. Construction of new health Centres:

Construction of three new health centres have been taken up under NUHM (National Urban Health Mission) at Alampur under ward no 10, Santoshpur Government Colony Bazar under ward no 16 and Boga Noapara under ward no 21.

Tender floated and work orders issued. It is expected that the primary health centres will be put to service of the citizens of the Mahaeshtala within a period of six months.

2. Infrastructural development:

Infrastructural development works of refugee colonies have been taken up in Santoshpur G.S. Colony under ward 16, Taltala G.S. Colony under ward 27 and Santoshpur Co-operative colony under ward 9. Fund of Rs. 4.11 crore has been sanctioned by the State Government in the Refugee Relief and Rehabilitation Department. Tenders have been floated. Work order will soon be issued.

3. Green Energy

A scheme for installation and connection of roof top solar PV sources of 15 KWP in the roof of the Municipal office building has been taken up. The west Bengal Green Energy Development Corporation, a Government of West Bengal Enterprise, is the implementing agency of the work.

4. Nirmal Bangla Abhiyan:

Declaring Maheshtala Municipality as an open – defecation - free town under ‘Amar Souchagar’ - Nirmal Bangla under National Sachha Bharat Mission is now the most important and vital programme of Maheshtala Municipality. The households having no own independent latrine have been identified.

The scheme to construct two pit latrine on each such household has been taken up at a cost of Rs. 10900/- each latrine.

5. Remarkable activities under NUHM (National Urban Health Mission):

- Pulse Polio Immunization Programme - September 25th was the Pulse Polio day, throughout the municipal area. 212 Pulse Polio booths were organized to administer Oral Polio Vaccine (OPV) to children below age of five years. From 26th September to 1st October 1,45,388 home was visited to ensure full coverage through polio vaccination. Total 41,612 children were given OPV through booth and home visit.

- To prevent dengue door to door campaign was made during 15th to 20th September. 99,960 homes were visited. For awareness generation 1,01,154 leaflets were distributed and 1,43,885 individual were reached through Individual Public Contact (IPC).



6. Activities under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- National Urban Livelihoods Mission: WBSULM (West Bengal Urban Livelihood Mission):

Apart from regular activities of the Mission merit evaluation of skill training is an integral part of the training course. In September 2016, examination of Beautician training was scheduled, which was a colorful event. Examinees were asked to do bridal make over along with complete bridal dress up. Also they were asked to decorate 'Tatwo' (decorating and displaying gift items for in laws) which is an important part of marriage ritual. Candidates did it very nicely.



The following regular activities took place in the month of September, 2016 in the Maheshtala Municipality –

- 4 Self Help Groups have been formed and group account opened in the respective banks
- In the meeting of the Task force held in this month four loan applications have been approved by the members. Concerned banks were also present in the meeting and they scrutinized the applications before approval.

- Orientation programme of Bank Branch representatives was an important event in this month. Representatives from 14 branches were present, including Lead District Manager (LDM). Besides orientation of bankers about DAY NULM another important agenda was identified about the bottlenecks that Community Organisers are facing while opening account of SHG and approval of loan applications. Some solutions were reached to solve the issues under the leadership of LDM.
- Skill trainings in various trades, like Computer, Spoken English, Beautician etc. are going on.
