Activities during the month of September 2022

Activities under National Urban Health Mission:

Regular Special Outreach Health Camps are conducted at different remote places of the ULB to provide health care services to the residents. Through these camps 1058 beneficiaries received medical services including free medicines.



210 pregnant women received antenatal

checkup services and advice regarding health and nutrition through Pradhan Mantri Surakshit Matritva Abhiyan (PMSMA). Mental health care services were accorded, so that would be mothers can deal with different changes that take place during this phase.

257 Regular Immunization camps were conducted and Urban Health &

Nutrition Day (UH&ND) was observed in the camps. Through these sessions new mothers are counseled and made aware about health and nutrition of their child. Due to negligence good nutrition is often

compromised and that hampers growth and development of the child. These camps help to inform them about nutritional requirement of the child and how to fulfill their need.



Activities under National Urban Livelihood Mission: WBSULM (West Bengal State Urban Livelihood Mission):

Shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH)

Regular health check up conducted every month with top most priority to minimize risk of health hazards for the inmates. A camp was organized on 12th September, and as per requirement



medicines were also provided to the inmates.

Special dinner for the inmates was arranged by the Executive Officer of Maheshtala Municipality, and this was enjoyed by all the residents of SUH.

Distribution of School Uniform

Before puja vacation 97 schools received 2 sets of school uniform and 110 schools received 1 set.



Empowerment of Women

Three new Self Help Groups (SHG), have got their group account and they have initiated micro savings and micro lending activities. Six SHGs, which are successfully following Pancha Sutra and running the groups properly; received one time revolving fund of ten thousand each. It will enhance their fund and help in micro lending.

Four SHGs received first Cash Credit Loans, amounting Rs. 1.5 lakh, four SHGs received second Cash Credit Loans, amounting Rs. 2.5 lakh and one SHG received fourth Cash Credit loan amounting Rs 6 lakh.

Forty members from eight Area Level Federations (ALF) received detailed training on roles and responsibilities of ALF. Through the training focus was given on developing soft skills like, leadership, communication etc. it will be beneficial for their personal life as well.
