Activities during the months of April to June 2021

Activities under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Urban Livelihoods Mission: WBSULM (West Bengal State Urban Livelihood Mission):

This financial year started with election fever followed by second wave of Covid 19 and lock down. That hampered regular activities a lot. Gradually things are falling into the places and project works are accelerating.

Empowerment of Women

Eleven SHGs which were formed in last financial year received basic orientation training. Six new Self Help Groups (SHG) have been formed and the groups have opened their group savings bank accounts. Fourteen SHGs, those are following *pancha sutra*, received one time revolving fund of rupees ten thousands each. Two Area Level Federations received one time revolving fund of rupees fifty thousand each. Five SHGs received first cash credit loan



of Rs. 1.5 lakh. Two SHGs received second cash credit loan, @ Rs. 2.5 lakh each.

Shelter for Urban Homeless

31 inmates are now present at the shelter home. Thirteen inmates above the age of eighteen received 1st dose of Covid 19 Vaccine. Regular health check up, thermal checking and checking of oxygen level have been made mandatory during this period. From the month of May to July 2021 all the inmates are getting free food keeping in mind the situation of livelihood of the inmates. The building is being sanitized thrice a week to prevent infection.









Activities under National Urban Health Mission (NUHM):

Main focus was given on mass vaccination during this period. Street hawkers remain one of the vulnerable groups to get Covid 19. Total 7781 street hawkers received 1st dose of vaccine in this quarter. 1816 Transport worker got 1st dose of vaccine. Along with these special categories regular vaccination is going on.

Serosurveillance for SARS-CoV-2 infection was carried out to estimate and monitor the trend of infection in the adult general population, determine the socio-demographic risk factors and delineate the geographical spread of the infection. , 40 samples were collected





World No Tobacco Day was observed in all the health centers on 31 May. Besides taking oath to prevent use of tobacco, no tobacco campaign was taken up. Temporary Cyclone Yaas relief centre was set up in the municipal area, to give safe and secure shelter to the affected residents. Free food, water and medical support were given to those people.





34633 children below the age of five years received pulse polio drops through booths and door to door visits.
