Activities during the month of January 2023

Activities under National Urban Health Mission:



110 pregnant women received antenatal health checkup and advice through Pradhan Mantri Surakshit Matritva Abhiyan (PMSMA) is a focused intervention to ensure low risk pregnancy and safe delivery during this month from five Urban Primary Health Center under Maheshtala Municipality.

27 health outreach camps were organized in the month of January and total 894 community people received service and medicines through the camp.

Measles-Rubella (MR) Vaccination Campaign (MRVC):



MRVC launched on 9th January 2023; is a special campaign to vaccinate all children from 9 months to 15 years age group with one additional dose of MR vaccine. The MR dose is given to all targeted children, both immunized and unimmunized, irrespective of prior measles/rubella infection history. The goal of the campaign is to accelerate population immunity by reaching 100% target children with MR vaccine that will reduce cases and deaths from measles and related complications.

Initially three weeks of campaign has been carried out at schools and anganwadi centers. Next two weeks to be carried out at community level through Urban Primary Health Centers and health workers.

Activities under National Urban Livelihood Mission: WBSULM (West Bengal State Urban Livelihood Mission):

Shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH)



At Shelter for Urban Homeless 23rd January and 26th January observed by the inmates with due respect. A local well wisher provided special lunch on 23rd of January.





Monthly health check up camp was organized on 18th January, and as per prescription of doctor, medicines were also provided to the inmates. Besides, medicinal support advice was provided by the doctor to maintain better health.

A well wisher distributed blankets to the inmates and spends some time with the

inmates and had general discussion.



A tiny inmate, who is a student of class nine, has enrolled herself in the NCC



and joined her first NCC camp. She earned appreciation from the military officials for her performance in the drill for the junior section.



Several seasonal vegetables are harvested in the tiny kitchen garden of SUH. This appears to be a good effort made by the inmates.

Empowerment of Women

13 SHGs received Capacity Building training in this month. During training participants came to know about the benefits, rules and regulations of Self Help Group. Leaders of the groups were taught about the accounting process of SHG and maintenance of all the books.

Two new Self Help Groups (SHG) got their savings bank accounts opened, and initiated process of micro savings. Eleven SHGs were graded successfully in this month and their applications were forwarded to the concerned bank branches for sanction of first dose of cash credit loan



Two SHGs received first Cash Credit Loans, amounting Rs. 1.5 lakh, one SHG received second Cash Credit Loans, amounting Rs. 2.5 lakh.
