### Activities during the month of August 2019

#### 1. Activities under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission: WBSULM (West Bengal State Urban Livelihood Mission):

- Six Self Help Groups were formed in the month of August consisting of 68 members in total. 275 SHGs members from 55 different SHGs received Basic Orientation Training and Books of Accounts training. This training would improve their understanding on NULM, its activities and role of Self Help Groups in their lives and society as well.

Four Ward based Area Level Federation formed in this month in ward no. 22, 23, 24 and 29 Wards. This ALF will be registered under Society Registration Act and will help to ease activities of the livelihood mission.

- 9 SHGs were graded and sponsored to bank for cash credit loans. One SHG got its 2<sup>nd</sup> Cash Credit loan, which is 2.5 lakhs during this month five SHGs which were graded previously received Cash Credit Loans of Rs. 1.5 lakh.



- In collaboration with Bangiya Gramin Vikash Bank, Jagannathnagar branch a financial literacy camp was organized. The camp was facilitated by senior personnel of the branch. 10 SHGs attended the camp. Through the camp information on maintenance of Cash Credit account and other financial facilities of different government schemes were discussed.

- In collaboration with Labour Department an orientation programme was arranged for the SHG members and Community Organisers on Samajik Suraksha Yojna which has different kinds of schemes for the benefit of the unorganized labourers and their families.
