#### Activities in July, 2016

# 1) Gitanjali housing scheme :

This scheme for providing shelter to the poorer section of the society at a low cost has been sanctioned by the State Government in the Housing Department. The cost of the housing is Rs. 70000/- per beneficiary. We have sent a list of 50 beneficiaries to the housing department for sanction.

This is a popular programme of the state government and we are proud to be associated with the programme.

# 2) Restriction on use of plastic carry bags etc.

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has brought out a new rule, viz, Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016.

These rules shall apply to every waste generators, local bodies, plastic goods sellers etc.

# The operative part of the rules is furnished below for information of all concerned.

- 1. Each plastic carry bag not below 50 micron in thickness shall be produced by the manufacturer.
- 2. The manufacturer shall have to label each plastic carry bag with the name and registration number, thickness, whether made from compostable plastic or with mark in case recycled plastic.
- 3. Consent to operate permission has to be obtained from the West Bengal Pollution Control Board.
- 4. Any shopkeeper may use authorized micron (50 micron) carry bag for his customers but he has to register with the Maheshtala Municipality for such use for obtaining permission on payment of <u>monthly fees of Rs. 4000/-</u> failing which he shall be liable for prosecution.

# 3) Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission: WBSULM (West Bengal Urban Livelihood Mission):

The following activities took place in the month of July, 2016 in the Maheshtala Municipality -

i. 7 Self Help Groups have been formed and group account opened in the respective bank. Each of the groups consists of 10-13 poor urban women.

- ii. Three Area Level Federations (AFL) have been formed in ward number 5, 30 and 35.
  Each FLF consists of 13 Self Help Groups.
  Three office bearers of each group are members of the federation. Theses federations shall be registered under Society Registration Act. An orientation programme, consisting all the members of three ALFs was organized in this month at the Municipality.
- iii. Orientation of Ward Councillors under Maheshtala Municipality was organized to orient them on Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission and its benefit so that they can identify more and more beneficiaries at their level and forward them to Municipality for accessing benefits for their socio-economic upgradation.
- iv. At the Task Force meeting five Self Employment Programme – Individual (SEP-I) Ioan applications were approved. These applications are forwarded to the respective banks for consideration.
- Regular skill trainings in various trades, like
   Computer, Spoken English, Beautician
   course etc. are going on.
